Description:

Juniper framed, AB fir marine plywood planked hull. 2 layers of plywood overall totaling 1 inch on the bottom and ½ inch on the sides. 1708 fiberglass cloth over and Gougeon epoxy inside and out. Awlgrip painted finish.

The cockpit boasts an insulated fish box, ice chest and bait rigging station as well as fresh and saltwater washdowns. The cockpit mezzanine is light weight and first class; our relationship with Spencer Yachts has favored BB Boats with the opportunity to purchase the foam core and vacuum bagged mezzanine off their line. Triple spreader Rupp Outriggers are installed.

The interior includes a charter style salon, forward cabin, companionway crew bunks and a single head. Tackle storage, lockers and bait freezer are located below. A 24,000 BTU Cruisair is powered by a Phasor generator.

The 2010 hull is the 31st boat over 55 feet that Buddy Cannady has built in his career. This hull marks a milestone for BB Boats, Inc. as this is the first hull lofted by Bill Maxwell. A true traditional boat building operation, BB Boats guarantees price and delivery in the winter of 2010.

While there is still time to choose the power package, fuel and water capacities, interested parties are strongly urged to keep the fuel to weight ratio in mind. A fishing machine, Hull #31 will be seaworthy, efficient and quick. The best attainable speed without compromising the boat's efficiency, however, will be to add shaft tubes and Veemes propellers.
